Dr. V. Krishna Ananth, presently Associate Professor in the Department of History, Sikkim University, had his higher education from the Centre for Historical Studies, **Jawaharalal Nehru University, New Delhi**. After his Masters in History, Dr. Ananth completed his MPhil and PhD under the supervision of Late Prof. Sabyasachi Bhattacharya on topics concerning the Trade Union Movement. He spent some years working as a journalist, most of those with The Hindu, reporting and commenting on political, developmental and constitutional issues. He was Fellow, Nehru Memorial Museum and Library, New Delhi between May 2009 and April 2011. He is author of books such as: *India Since Independence: Making Sense of Politics in India*, Pearson, 2009, *Politics in the Times of Churning: A Journalist's Perception*, Daya Publications 2014, *The Indian Constitution and Social Revolution: Right to Property Since Independence*, Sage 2015 and also contributed chapters in edited volumes.
