COMMENCEMENT OF OFFLINE REGULAR CLASSES

In view of the notification issued by the Education Department, Government of Sikkim vide notification Ref No: 84/SPD/SS/Edn/2021-22 dated 29/08/2021 and the subsequent meeting with the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor and the faculty member, it has been decided that the Odd semester will commence from 20th September, 2021 on physical regular classes (Offline) adhering to the COVID-19 Pandemic SOP issued by the Competent Authority. The students are advised to check the ODD Semester Academic Calendar 2021 in the University website.

In regard to the same the outstation students are advised to return to the state of Sikkim adhering to the entry -exit guidelines issued by the Government of Sikkim and advised to follow the following instruction.

- 1. Physical distancing of atleast 6 feet to be followed in and around the campus.
- Use of face covers/masks is mandatory.
- 3. Frequent hand wash with soap (for atleast 40-60 seconds) even when hands are not visibly dirty and use of alcohol-based hand sanitizer are to be done when ever feasible.
- 4. Respiratory etiquettes to be strictly followed. This involves strict practice of covering one's mouth and nose while coughing/sneezing with a tissue/ handkerchief/flexed elbow and disposing of used tissues properly.
- 5. Self-monitoring of health by all and reporting any illness at the earliest.
- 6. Spitting in and around campus is strictly prohibited.
- 7. Mandatory Installation and use of Aarogya Setu App.

The students are also requested to take the Covid vaccine as per the Government of India guidelines.

The University follows various COVID-19 guidelines/order issued by the Government of India/State Government of Sikkim from time to time. It is the students' responsibility to strictly adhere to the COVID-19 safety instruction and breach may make them vulnerable to get infected. We request all the students to always abide by the prescribed norms to keep themselves safe.
